- Individualised Support Package Eligible
- Attending Secondary College – may be in last year of school or at risk of leaving prematurely

BEST Options is now providing a flexible 1:1 case management service to anyone on an Individualised Support Package, self funded or students within the secondary school system. This is a fee for service program and the purpose is to provide participants with the necessary supports to assist them to develop personal goals and a pathway to employment and education, training and community links.

BEST Options can tailor a case management support package to individuals based on their needs and goals for the future.

The participants can gain support in the following areas:

- career development
- skill identification
- personal development – self esteem, confidence, motivation, independence and self-worth
- communication
- pre-employment skills
- resume development and application letter writing
- cold canvassing
- interview techniques
- education and training options post school
- tutoring and mentoring support
- work experience and volunteer work
- travel training, L's and P's
- appropriate work place behaviour
- social club
- introduction to post school services
