Qualification Overview

Certificate III in Aged Care addresses work performed in residential facilities under regular supervision within clearly defined organisation guidelines and service plans.

These workers:

- Carry out activities to maintain personal care and/or other activities of living for people in an aged care setting.
- Carry out activities related to an individualised plan.
- Report directly to a supervisor and are not responsible for other workers.

Entry Requirements

There are no specific entry requirements for this qualification.

Course Content

A Certificate III in Aged Care requires ten core units and four elective units of competency to be successfully completed, in addition to a practical placement.

- CHCAC317A Support older people to maintain their independence
- CHCAC318B Work effectively with older people
- CHCAC319A Provide support to people living with dementia
- CHCCS411B Work effectively in the community sector
- CHCICS301A Provide support to meet personal care needs
- CHCICS302A Participate in the implementation of individualised plans
- CHCICS303A Support individual health and emotional well being
- CHCOHS312B Follow safety procedures for direct care work
- CHCPA301B Deliver care services using a palliative approach
- HLTAP301B Recognise healthy body systems in a health care context

Elective Units*

- HLTHIR403B Work effectively with culturally diverse clients and co-workers
- CHCCS305A Assist clients with medication (note: pre-requisite HLTAP301A)
- HLTF301B Apply first aid
- CHCDIS301A Work effectively with people with a disability

Certificate III in Aged Care is offered on a face to face basis, via distance learning, or as an Australian Traineeship.
