Qualification Overview

Certificate IV in Disability addresses work in residential group homes, training resource centres, day respite centres, other community settings and clients' homes. Workers with this qualification provide training and support to people with disabilities to enhance their ability to achieve greater levels of independence, self reliance and community participation. Workers often report to service managers and may liaise with health professionals and other service agencies. Workers may work without direct supervision and may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a limited number of lower classified workers.

Entry Requirements

There are no specific entry requirements for this qualification.

Course Content

Certificate IV in Disability requires ten core units and five elective units of competency to be successfully completed, in addition to a practical placement component of a minimum of 120 hours.

- CHCCS400A Work within a relevant legal and ethical framework
- CHCCS411A Work effectively in the community sector
- CHCDIS301A Work effectively with people with a disability
- CHCDIS302A Maintain an environment to empower people with disabilities
- CHCDIS405A Facilitate skills development and maintenance
- CHCDIS410A Facilitate community participation and inclusion
- CHCDIS411A Communicate using augmentative and alternative communication strategies
- CHCICS404A Plan and provide advanced behaviour support
- CHCICS402A Facilitate individualised plans
- CHCOHS312A Follow safety procedures for direct care work

Elective Units*

- HLTAP301A Recognise healthy body systems in a health care context
- CHCCS305A Assist clients with medication (note prerequisite HLTAP301A)
- HLTF301B Apply first aid
- HLTHIR403B Work effectively with culturally diverse clients and co-workers
- CHCMH402A Apply understanding of mental health issues and recovery processes

Certificate IV in Disability is offered on a face to face basis, via distance learning or as an Australian Traineeship.
